The Populist vote in rural areas increased, but most workers did not vote Populist Few Populist demands spoke to workers’ needs, as their calls for higher agricultural prices would raise food costs for workers and diminish the value of their wages, and the movement’s Protestant and revivalist culture alienated Catholic and immigrant workers
